Historic Preservation Open House to be held March 19

Naperville, Ill. — The joint committee working on recommendations related to the historic district and preservation in Naperville is hosting a public open house from 7 to 9 p.m. on Thursday, March 19, at the Naperville Municipal Center, 400 S. Eagle St. in Meeting Rooms B & C. The public is invited to attend to learn more about the status of work to date and preliminary thoughts on the revised recommendations being drafted for the City Council's consideration.

A short presentation will be made at 7 p.m. with discussion to follow. All feedback will be welcome. Since work is still in progress, information will be posted on the City of Naperville Web site, www.naperville.il.us, and the Naper Settlement Web site, www.napersettlement.museum, at least one day prior to the meeting.
